



NELLIE'S CELEBRATES RENOVATED SPACE!



On Wednesday July 28, 2010, women and children along with staff, board, volunteers, students funders and supporters all came together to celebrate Nellie's newly renovated Community Outreach Program space!

Since 1973, Nellie's has been at the frontlines of helping to rebuild the lives of over 15,000 women and their children impacted by violence, poverty, homelessness and oppression.

This spring, renovations to Nellie's Community Support and Outreach drop-in space included the installation of a new lift, bathroom and frontage to help accommodate accessibility. Funding for the renovations was provided by the Ontario Trillium Foundation, which is an agency of the Government of Ontario, the Ministry of Community and Social Services Violence Against Women's Program, the City of Toronto and the Big Carrot Collective.
